STATEMENT OF PRINCIPAL

The Equine Canada Federation (EC), the national federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibiting procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

**THE RULE BOOK**

Exhibitors, Judges, and Show Officials are responsible for knowledge of the Rules. Both a complete knowledge of and compliance with the rules are essential, and all participants must be fully cognizant of all rules as well as class specifications in the division in which they compete. Full details of Horse Show operation - EC (including FEI) rules - list of recognized Judges - **other vital information is in the RULE BOOK** copyright for exclusive use of recognized shows. See current EC Rules and Amendments. Every individual is eligible to count points won at recognized EC Shows for Annual and Provincial Championship Awards. The current EC Rules and Amendments are presently in effect and have been used to compile the Rules and Regulations for this prize list. Passports are NOT required in a recognized "Breed" competition.

**Regional & National Breed Shows require a Silver License**

**Amateur Competitors:** All seniors competing in EC amateur classes must possess a current amateur card. This must be applied for at the same time as the "Competitive License".

Membership to EC is now called a "Competitive License". *All exhibitors, owners, trainers, riders, drivers, handlers must join EC with a competitive license to be able to compete in any EC sanctioned show.*

**NOTE**

**Temporary Sport License** is available at a show for \$55.00 and does not accrue points.

**Single Event Sport License Upgrade** is for a competitor arriving at a competition without the correct Sport License Level. The competitor pays a fee of \$15.00 to the competition to compete at a level higher than their current license. This upgrade is valid only for that competition and does not accrue points. Permanent upgrade must be done directly through the EC Office.

### **RESPONSIBLE PERSON**

The person Responsible is the individual responsible and accountable for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. The Person Responsible may be the trainer or maybe an owner, rider, driver, agent or coach. The Person Responsible must be an adult and must hold an EC individual or group license (see A203.5) also see A214.2 in the case of junior entries, parents/guardian are entitled to sign their child's entry form without holding an EC Sport License - \*\*\*\*\*SIGNATURE IS REQUIRED ON THE BACK OF THE ENTRY FORM\*\*\*\*\*

## GENERAL INFORMATION

All classes in this show will be governed by the current EC Rules and amendments and the current AHA Handbook and amendments. Therefore, it meets all requirements for eligibility of National and Regional Championship classes and Achievement Awards points. In the case of any discrepancy, AHA rules will prevail and if not covered then the EC rules will apply. The Show Committee reserves the right to decide on any rule not covered by EC and/or AHA. All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.

Any horse entered in any class at a competition is subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees and may, while on the competition grounds be selected for equine medication control testing.

Grooms entering the ring are to appear neat, clean and suitably attired in the opinion of the Show Committee (i.e. unmarked smock).

No person other than the officials, steward, attendants on duty, and the Judge of the class may enter the show ring without the permission of the Judge.

Exhibitors are responsible for reporting all entries to the Gate Attendant ten minutes before each respective class is called for showing and **must** enter the ring promptly when called. Those **not** ready when called **will not** be allowed to enter the ring to compete. No fees will be refunded.

Horses **shall not** be punished unnecessarily or severely anywhere on the Show Grounds. Rules regarding cruelty and abuse are covered by the EC Rule Book and will be enforced.

Any Exhibitor using a wrong back number or having no number may be excused or disqualified from the class at the discretion of the Judge of the class. No fees will be refunded.

**Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise rings – PLEASE COMPLY WITH THIS RULE AS it is an EC rule and the Steward will be enforcing it.**

Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler, the owner may forfeit his entry fee and such action will be reported to EC. Show Management reserves to itself the power to remove any person or horse from the Show or the Show Grounds without being liable for compensation.

Courses/patterns will be posted at least **one** hour before the class at the Show Office and in an area designated by the Show Committee.

All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the Show Arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that an **exhibitor** has made or caused to be made a false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited or if any **exhibitor** shall attempt to interfere with the Judge in the performance of his/her duties, that exhibitor shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In case of any animal being disqualified the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that has been awarded to such animal and lowest prize in the class shall go to the reserve number.

The Show Steward shall have the full power to act for & on behalf of the Show Committee during the entire show.

The Show Committee reserves the right to **add to, amend, or decide** any point **not** covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary alterations in the prize list or show program.

**Trail & Reining Classes** Weather permitting all trail & reining classes will be held in the outdoor arena.

The number of horses calculated as competing are at the closing of the gate and the beginning of the class for all classes shown as a group and all those who pass through the gate in individual activity.

**- All AHA approved shows will use the new halter scoring system for Breeding & In-Hand Arabian & Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian halter classes as outlined in the 2011 AHA handbook.** You may review this system on the AHA website –Competition –Judges-Stewards section.

### ARABIAN BREEDERS SWEEPSTAKES INFORMATION

**Sweepstakes Point Payback prize money is available at every AHA recognized event, just like this one!**

*If you have a Sweepstakes Nominated Original Entry, Breeding Entry, Gelding Entry or Yearling Entry then your horse is now eligible to receive Sweepstakes prize money in Sweepstakes classes with the Points Payback Program. Enroll your horse before the first date of competition for \*100 U.S. and points will be earned with pay back at the end of the competition year!*

*Shows & Events will receive 55% of the total Sweepstakes payable fund to be paid based on points. Total number of points earned by enrolled Sweepstakes horses will be divided into 55% payout to determine dollar value per point. AHA will then mail a check to the recorded owner of the horse as of December 31 of the competition year based on results received throughout the year!*

***PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING***

1. Please read all rules and forms before completing the entry form. Errors are costly to everyone.
2. Full entry fees must accompany all entries.
3. Entries must be complete and **include copies** of the following:
  - a) **current registration papers** front & back for each horse entered
  - b) copy of **lease agreement** or **contract of sale** (*if applicable*)
  - c) copy of **membership cards** from AHA & EC for each *owner, rider, handler, driver*. Seniors & Youth
  - d) **EC Amateur** status \*\*\*Must be paid for each year\*\*\* (*if applicable*)
  - e) **Parent/Guardian signature for Minors on all signature lines. No Minor Signatures!**

**Entries will be considered incomplete if submitted without copies of registration papers and membership cards and a \$20.00 fee may be charged by the Show Secretary.**

**Collect calls will be made to exhibitors by the Show Secretary if deemed necessary to clarify any entry.**

**ELIGIBILITY**

The following **are eligible** to compete at this EC & AHA recognized show:

1. All riders, drivers, handlers, owners, lessees, agents, or trainers who are a member of EC & "Competition member" of AHA
2. Membership in only the Arabian Horse Association **does not** entitle exhibitors to show at an EC recognized show.
3. Any **individual** participating in this show **must** be a "Competition member" of an AHA Region member association - in good standing. Entries will NOT be accepted unless accompanied by a copy of the AHA membership card with legible number.
4. Temporary membership can be purchased for EC (Non-member fee) & A.H.A (Single Event Membership). These memberships would only be in effect for this show and do not carry forward to any other show nor with any yearly award points. **Affidavits for AHA are no longer allowed. If you do not have a current membership card then you will be required to purchase a Single Event Membership for each show that you enter. Temporary memberships are NOT allowed at the Regional or National level.**
5. All exhibitors over the age of eighteen competing in **Amateur** classes must be eligible for Amateur status as described in the EC current Rule Book. All exhibitors must also have a current EC Amateur Competition License. **Refer to EC 2010 Rules The Amateur status must be applied & paid for each year along with the EC Competitive License.**
6. Any person who **has not** reached their 18th birthday is regarded as an Amateur and is called a YOUTH. Youth exhibitors must also have a current membership in EC (if 10yrs of age or over) & AHA and must have a parent/guardian signature on the entry form on all signature lines including the minor consent form.
7. All horses entered in this show must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horses Registry, the Arabian Horse Registry of America or the Arabian Horse Association. Any horse registered with the Canadian Arabian Partbred Registry (CAHR) will not require a CPAR permit to show at a recognized Arabian show.
8. Combined ownership is **not** allowed in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the immediate family. See
9. **Select ATR, A0TR, JTR, J0TR** classes. EC Article B1502.6 Classes open to rider/driver/handler that has NOT won ANY of the following:
  - a) AHA Regional Top Five or higher in that particular performance section in which they are shown.
  - b) AHA National Top Ten or higher in that particular performance section in which they are shown.
  - c) Two AHA Regional Top Five Awards or higher in a Select class of that particular performance section in which they are shown/
  - d) An AHA Nationals Top Ten or higher award in a Select class in that particular performance section in which they are shown.

Riders of Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian horses competing in the same section shall not be considered separately. If a rider is eligible to compete as a Select rider in a respective section on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year.

### ENTRIES

1. Entries must be postmarked no later than **June 7, 2011.**

**AFTER June 7, 2011 All new entries will be considered a late entry and will pay a late entry fee of \$20.00 per entry form no matter what date the post mark is on the envelope.**

2. Management agrees to cancel and refund entry & stall fees on any horse unable to show providing notice, in writing, is received by the Show Secretary on or before June 7, 2011. A \$20.00 processing fee, office and number fee will be retained.
3. Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after June 7, 2011 will forfeit entry fees unless a suitable Veterinarian Certificate attesting to illness/injury is received, in writing, by the Show Secretary before 8:00 pm on Friday, July 1, 2011. A \$20.00 processing charge, office, number and stall fee will be retained from all refunds.
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any class with three (3) entries or less at the closing date of entries. If a class is cancelled, entry fees will be refunded. Large classes may be split at the discretion of the Show Management, with each section run back to back. Classes split by Age Grouping may be combined if the numbers do not warrant running as split.
5. Exhibitors will be called collect if entries are incomplete, not correct, or as deemed necessary by the Show/Entries Secretary.
6. There will be a **\$30.00** charge for any **Returned Cheque.**

## AHA EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES \*\*\* SPECIFICATIONS \*\*\*

### AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL

1. Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from EC B3602 & G1010.4 shall be required.
3. To receive a medal in this class three competitors with proper appointments must compete. see below
4. **Exhibitors in this division must wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.**

### AHA HUNTER SEAT OVER FENCES MEDAL

1. Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st.
2. To be shown over a course of not less than six obstacles at 2'6" feet which must include an oxer and two changes of direction (changes of lead). Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required from EC Article G1110.4 & B3602. Only one rider per horse.
3. To receive a medal in this class three competitors with proper appointments must compete. see below
4. **Exhibitors in this division must wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.**

### AHA SADDLE SEAT MEDAL

1. Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests, from EC B3604.
3. To receive a medal in this class three competitors with proper appointments must compete. see below
4. **Protective headgear secured with a safety harness is recommended and may be worn without penalty.**

### AHA REINING SEAT MEDAL

1. Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st
2. All contestants are required to perform both rail work & a Reining Pattern as outlined in the EC B3606.4 (NRHA reining patterns)
3. Dropping of bits is optional with the Judge, but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
4. To receive a medal in this class three competitors with proper appointments must compete. see below
5. In AHA Reining Seat Medal Class an off pattern rider is eliminated and not eligible to win a medal or a ribbon.
6. **Protective headgear secured with a safety harness is recommended and may be worn without penalty.**

### AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL

1. Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st .
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests, from EC rulebook B3701
3. To receive a medal in this class three competitors with proper appointments must compete. see below
4. **Protective headgear secured with a safety harness is recommended and may be worn without penalty.**

COMP709.6a

*For ALL AHA Medal classes with less than three (3) competitors, AHA Medal points will be earned.*

**Medal winners may ride in any Medal class throughout the year. (AHA COMP 709.1.b)**

**Once an equitation class or section at any show has begun, no individual shall ride or school a horse entered in that class unless that individual is the person entered on and showing said horse. Any violation shall result in disqualification of horse and rider from that class. (refer to current AHA rulebook – COMP 709.9)**

**Western Seat Equitation** - No Reining Pattern. Tests may be called. Protective headgear secured with a safety harness is recommended and may be worn without penalty.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP will require a pattern even though there is a Medal class which will also run a pattern.

*For all other class specifications refer to the current EC Rules and the current AHA Handbook.*

#### Protective Headgear

Article A905 states a) Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds.

Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) standards and displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable.

- Article A905 states – It is strongly recommended that all persons wear ASTM/SEI or BSI approved headgear at all times while mounted or driving cross country or marathon.

Article A802 states – All entry forms at competitions that are subject to the new junior headgear rule must include the following acknowledgement and ensure that the entry form is signed by the parent/guardian.

Directly from EC – “Is approved headgear compulsory for ALL junior exhibitors?”

*“At present, if the junior is competing in a discipline or breed whose rules specify other headgear (e.g. western hats, derbies etc) those rules supersede the new rule. However, all breeds and disciplines do allow protective headgear with no penalty and we urge their members to put safety ahead of tradition and adopt the new rule. Therefore, no helmets are mandatory as yet in Saddle Seat or Western classes but they are recommended. Approved headgear is mandatory in all over fences classes. Hunt Seat on the flat must wear approved helmets complete with harness.” Dressage classes also require approved headgear.*

NEW – B1501.22 NEW for 2011

DRESSAGE riders are subject to Dressage rule E 4.0.3 Safety Headgear.

ASTM/SEI or BSI must be worn by all riders competing in Forth Level and below, Materiale and Equitation classes at EC Arabian breed Bronze and Silver competitions. This rule applies whenever the dressage rider is mounted on the competition grounds or warming up for a test. Penalty for contravening 4.0.1 is elimination. At the tack check which follows the test, the steward may ask the rider to dismount so that the helmet may be inspected for the ASTM/SEI or BSI label. Riders warming up and competing in all other Arabian divisions are NOT subject to this rule but are subject to the rules of their division or discipline.

#### RULES REGARDING PROTESTS

*A protest at a ECF recognized competition, other than those specific matters covered in division rules, must comply with the following:*

1. A protest is eligible only if made by the officiating Judge, an owner, lessee, trainer, competitor, or authorized agent in the Division in which the question arises. A protest must be made in writing and addressed to the Show Secretary of the competition at which the matter under consideration occurs, must be signed, and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 in cash. A copy of the protest must be sent to the ECF National Office and a participating Provincial Office.
2. A protest must contain a specific statement of an alleged violation of a rule or of a condition of a class and must give the full name and, if possible, the address of the alleged violator. The maker of the protest must be prepared to substantiate the protest or charge by personal testimony, sworn statements, witnesses or other relevant evidence.
3. A protest must be filed within forty eight hours (48) of the completion of the class concerned.
4. For further information regarding protests and appeals, refer to ECF current Rule book.

**Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown**

Exhibitors, attendant and headers must meet the specifications for amateur status. Horses are not to have been professionally trained for a **period of one year immediately prior** to the competition (riding and driving instruction for the owner to be excluded). In addition, horses re NOT to be exhibited, prepared, groomed or schooled with the aid of or by a professional while on or off the competition grounds immediately before or during the competition. Horses may be stabled with a professional and hauled by a professional. Professional help for situations relevant to safety is permitted. Owner must sign as owner, trainer and rider/driver/handler on the AHA entry blank.

**Halter**

**All AHA approved shows will use the new halter scoring system for Breeding & In-Hand Arabian & Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian halter classes as outlined in the 2010 AHA handbook.**
